The Kidney and Urinary program at St. Joseph's Healthcare is the regional referral and renal transplantation centre in south central Ontario for patients with end stage renal disease.

The program is one of the largest regional programs in the province supporting more than 2,000 patients and providing a spectrum of care from tertiary acute to chronic management of kidney disease

On May 10, 2017 St. Joseph's live-streamed a living donor kidney transplant to raise awareness about kidney disease and the importance of organ donation. The care team was available inside and outside the operating room to answer questions from the local community and beyond. The event reached 36 million people, according to Media Relations Rating Points (MRP). The donor was the patient's wife and the transplant was a success. (www.stjoes.ca/livestream)

Thanks Dr. Ribic, Megan, Lauren and the St. Joseph's team for making this happen - great work!

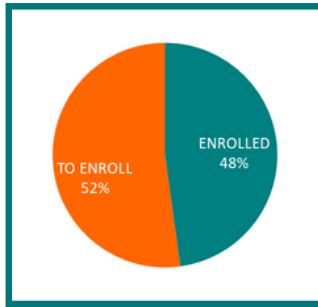
THANK YOU !

She is the Medical Director of Transplant and the HLA Laboratory Director for the St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton Transplant Program. She completed a Master of Science in Pharmacology at the University of Toronto in 2001 and a Master of Science in the Health Research Methodology Program at McMaster University. She is also the Chair of the Trillium Gift of Life Network (TGLN) HLA Advisory Committee and the Division Director of Nephrology at McMaster.

Dr. Ribic's research interests are in the area of renal transplantation and end stage renal disease with a focus on disease prevention and health outcomes.

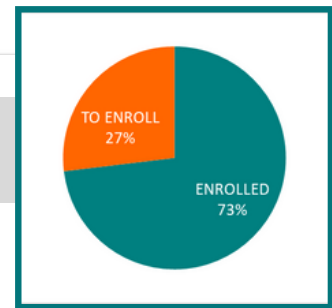
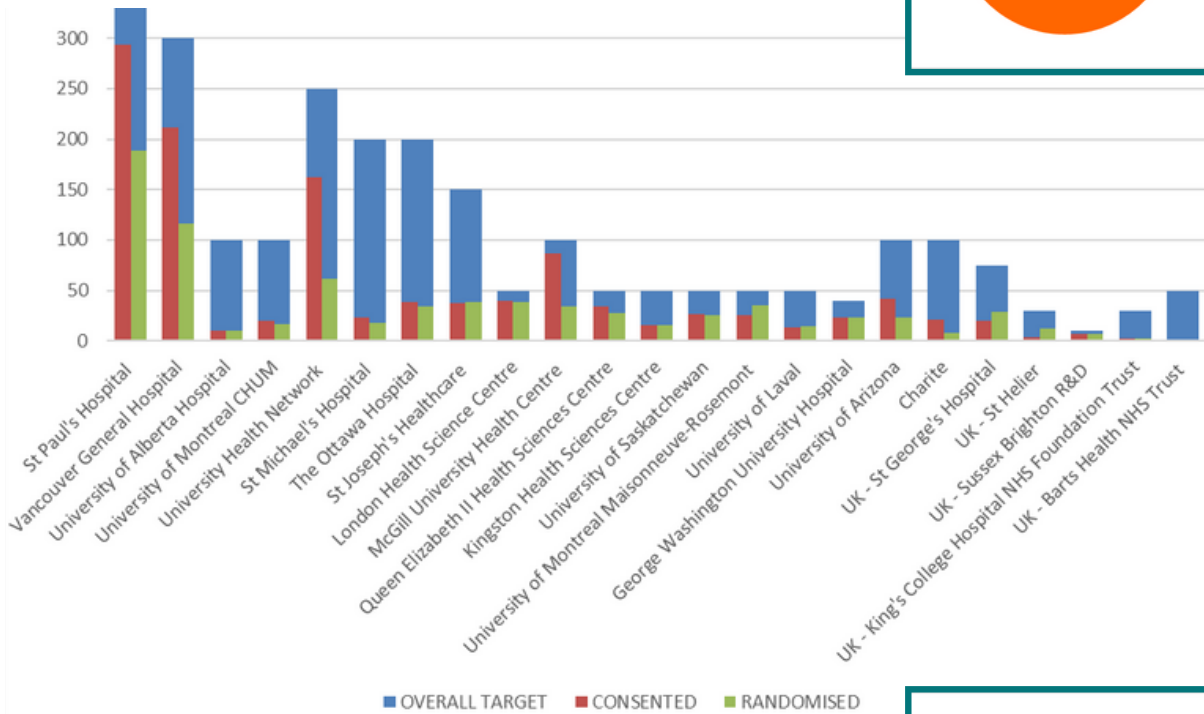
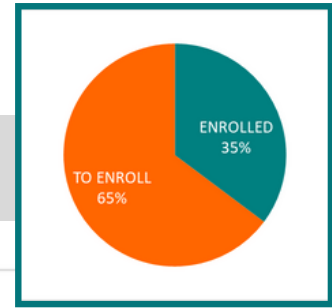
