Here is their winning strategy:

1- Weekly screening by reviewing the wait list patients' records and patients' pre-transplant evaluation visits
2- Approach the eligible active/not active patients who are on the wait-list and consent them in clinic.

3- If patients are not yet active, check back frequently until they are activated

4- Randomize!
